Dear Saints:

After considerable searching, we have reached an agreement for the purchase of a property for a meeting hall of the Church in Dublin. The Lord has sovereignly led us to this building after a prior opportunity did not work out. The building is in Dublin 8, a prime city centre area, and is within 15 minutes walking distance to Trinity College. The interior space was recently refurbished and does not require renovation. (Please review the attached video.)

After a previous buyer had to withdraw, we have agreed with the Seller to a price of €1.15 million euros, which is quite reasonable in this market. However, time is of the essence because the Seller is requiring a 30 day closing, i.e. the end of July. .

As one of nine target cities in Europe, Dublin has strategic importance in the Recovery as the only predominantly English speaking city in the EU. It is also a very significant city in the history of the Lord's move because of the influence of the early Brethren who started here. Brother Nee described their start as the reality of the Church in Philadelphia in The Orthodoxy of the Church:

In 1825 in Dublin, the capital of Ireland, there were several believers whose hearts were moved by God to love all the children of the Lord, regardless of their denomination. This kind of love was not to be frustrated by the walls of denomination. They began to see that in the Scriptures God says there is but one Body of Christ, regardless of how many sects men may divide her into.

As a continuation of this spiritual inheritance, the Lord's Table was established in Dublin in 2005. There are now about 70 in the Table meeting, and the need for a suitable meeting hall has become increasingly clear.
